

# *Southeast Diesel Collaborative Fifth Annual Clean Diesel Photo Contest*



The Southeast Diesel Collaborative is pleased to announce its fifth annual **Clean Diesel Photo Contest**. The photo contest will be part of the upcoming SEDC's 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Partners meeting. The photos should reflect the mission statement of the Southeast Diesel Collaborative (SEDC) and each should illustrate and highlight the theme for the entered category in a creative manner. Entrants may submit up to **three** images per each category listed below and may enter a total of six images. All photos are eligible for the People's Choice Awards which will be based upon the results of voting by all attendees at the Meeting. Awards will be made for the first, second and third place images in each category. All judging will be "blind" with the photographer's name not displayed during the judging period. All submitted photographs must have been taken by the **SEDC member** submitting the image (please). **Please note two very important rules: Only submit what you have personally photographed!-no ad campaign photos! Also, all photographs must have a short description of how the diesel engine(s) in the photo have been cleaned up in order to reduce emissions.** All photographs are also eligible for the Judges' Special Best of Show award. Additionally, the photographer retains the rights to the image and the SEDC

reserves the right to use the image in its outreach program. Please read the following rules and information carefully. **Please submit your entries by August 5, 2015** so they may be put into a presentation for the meeting.

## **SEDC Clean Diesel Photo Contest Categories:**

### **General Photo Competition:**

***NOTE: New Category!***

***Diesel Engines- then and now:*** Images of clean diesels being operated as compared to a similar engine that is not clean. An example is an old, smoking diesel car next to a clean, non-smoking diesel car.

***Clean Diesels and People:*** Images of clean diesels being operated around people, sensitive populations, etc., as well as SEDC members working on clean diesel projects.

***Clean Diesels at Work or Clean Fuels:*** Images of clean diesels in a work environment. Images representing the growing or processing of biodiesel feedstocks or the use of biodiesel or other clean fuel for diesels.

### **Judges' Special Photo Competition:**

***Best in Show:*** One photograph from all of the above categories will be selected by the SEDC Strategic Planning Committee members as best representing clean diesels.

## **SEDC Photo Contest Rules:**

**Please note two very important rules: Only submit what you have personally photographed!-no ad campaign photos! Also, all photographs must have a short description of how the diesel engine(s) in the photo have been cleaned up in order to reduce emissions. Entries without this description will not be accepted.**

All entries must be the work of the entrant and must have been taken within the lifetime of the SEDC, beginning January 2010 to the present. Metadata will be checked.

All entries must be submitted as both a digital image in .JPEG format as well as a photograph. The photographs do not need to be matted or framed. Maximum resolution for the JPEG file is 1600 x 1200 and a minimum resolution is 1024 x 768. The maximum size for photographs is 11" x 14" Photographs are requested in advance of the meeting, but may be hand delivered on the first day of the meeting. Photographs will be returned to the entrant after the end of the contest and before the end of the SEDC 7th Annual Partner's Meeting.

The photographers name, contact information, and title of the image (if one is used) must be written on the back of the photograph or matte board if the photograph is matted.

Each entrant may submit up to **three** images per category and a maximum of six images.

The photographer retains the rights to the image and the SEDC reserves the right to use the image in its outreach program.

Each entrant agrees to make no claim against the SEDC or hotel liable for loss or any damage to the image.
